Below are examples of shared decisions that arise during different stages of your match journey. 1. MATCHING STAGE

- ✿ What kind of relationship are you hoping for?

- ✿ Is there a maximum number of attempts of embryo transfers?

2. PRE-PREGNANCY STAGE

- ✿ What travel - not related to the surrogacy journey - is acceptable?
- ✿ Is it desired that family members, such as children and parents, meet each other during the journey?
- ✿ How many embryos are transferred?

3. PREGNANCY STAGE

- ✿ Who will attend the prenatal appointments?
- ✿ When are second opinions obtained? Non-routine
- ✿ What if a change in medical providers or delivery hospital is needed?
- ✿ In what circumstances will we need to discuss terminating a pregnancy?

4. BIRTH PLAN STAGE

- ✿ Who will be in attendance in the delivery room?
